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III USB Operation Note: Our USB slot is for USB sticks only. For play of other brands of media, please use the auxiliary input.

- A. Insert a USB stick into the USB slot. Songs must be in mp3 or wma format.
- B、Press the ▼ or ▲ for track down/track up respectively.
- C. Press ▶ button to pause the current track; press ▶ li again to resume the track.
- D、A long press of the ▼ or ▲ will reverse and fast forward the current track respectively.
- E. Once you exit the boat/vehicle/spa, always remove the USB stick from the USB port so as to prevent damage to the stick.

IV . Auxiliary Input Mode

- A. Press the Mode button until "AUX" appears on the LCD screen.
- B. The use of auxiliary mode allows you to play the portable music device through the headphone jack. In order to accomplish this, an auxiliary adaptor must be used (our SEAMINI2 is recommended).
- V 、Bass, Treble, Balance, Fader, Loud, Equalizer, Area Tuning A. To adjust bass, treble, balance, and fader, long press the
 - MODE button until the BAS feature appears. If you want to change the bass then use the VOL+ or VOL- button. To adjust the treble, balance, and fader setting, long press the MODE button until the BAS feature appears, then quickly press the MODE button until TRE appears. Repeat this step for balance (BAL), and fader (FAD). Adjust with the VOL+ or VOL-button.
 - B. To enter LOUD mode, long press the Mode button until BAS appears, then quickly press the MODE button until LOUD appears. Adjust to either ON or OFF using the VOL+ or VOL-.

Please note that the USB input only reads USB sticks. It is not designed to play other forms of portable media nor is it a charging station.




- C_{\times} To enter a specific equalizer setting, long press the MODE button until BAS appears, then quickly press the MODE button until EQ appears. Use the VOL+ or VOL- button to adjust (options include FLAT, CLASSIC, POP, ROCK, or EQ OFF).
- D. To enter AREA tuning mode, long press the MODE button until BAS appears, then quickly press the MODE button until AREA appears. Use the VOL+ or VOL- to designate between U.S and European frequency.

VI、Clock Adjustment



Clock display and adjustment: Long press the BAND button until the time displays. While time is displayed, long press the BAND button again until hour is flashing. Then adjust hour with volume buttons. Once hour is set, quick press BAND until the minutes are flashing then adjust with volume buttons. New time setting will be accepted automatically.







Stereo Receiver built for the Outdoors

Once suitable location is determined, drill the hole and secure the stereo using the metal mounting bracket.


If the bracket needs to be shorted, remove the appropriate number of breakaway segments using a pair of pliers.
